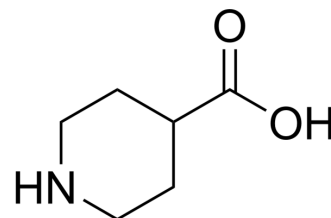

Description	Isonipecotic acid is a GABAA receptor partial agonist ^[1] .
IC₅₀ & Target	GABAA Receptor ^[1]
In Vitro	Isonipecotic acid inhibits [³ H]GABA binding (2°C) with an IC ₅₀ of 0.33 μM ^[2] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
