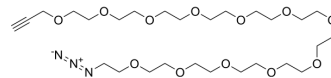

### BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Description	Azido-PEG12-propargyl is a PEG-based PROTAC linker that can be used in the synthesis of PROTACs <sup>[1]</sup> . Azido-PEG12-propargyl is a click chemistry reagent, it contains an Alkyne group and can undergo copper-catalyzed azide-alkyne cycloaddition (CuAAC) with molecules containing Azide groups.
IC <sub>50</sub> & Target	PEGs
In Vitro	PROTACs contain two different ligands connected by a linker; one is a ligand for an E3 ubiquitin ligase and the other is for the target protein. PROTACs exploit the intracellular ubiquitin-proteasome system to selectively degrade target proteins <sup>[1]</sup> . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods.
