## **BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY**

Description	Lenalidomide-4-aminomethyl is the Lenalidomide-based cereblon (CRBN) ligand used in the recruitment of CRBN protein. Lenalidomide-4-aminomethyl can be connected to the ligand for protein by a linker to form $PROTAC^{[1]}$ .
IC <sub>50</sub> & Target	Cereblon
In Vitro	PROTACs contain two different ligands connected by a linker; one is a ligand for an E3 ubiquitin ligase and the other is for the target protein. PROTACs exploit the intracellular ubiquitin-proteasome system to selectively degrade target proteins <sup>[2]</sup> . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods.
