BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Description	Thalidomide-NH-amido-PEG4-C2-NH2 is a synthesized E3 ligase ligand-linker conjugate that incorporates the Thalidomide based cereblon ligand and a linker used in PROTAC technology $^{[1]}$.
IC ₅₀ & Target	Cereblon
In Vitro	PROTACs contain two different ligands connected by a linker; one is a ligand for an E3 ubiquitin ligase and the other is for the target protein. PROTACs exploit the intracellular ubiquitin-proteasome system to selectively degrade target proteins ^[2] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods.
