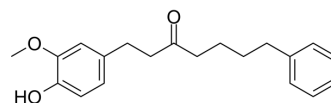

	2. Add each solvent one by one: 10% DMSO >> 90% (20% SBE-β-CD in saline) Solubility: ≥ 2.5 mg/mL (8.00 mM); Clear solution						
	3. Add each solvent one by one: 10% DMSO >> 90% corn oil Solubility: ≥ 2.5 mg/mL (8.00 mM); Clear solution						

BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Description	Yakuchinone A is a natural product isolated from the fruit of <i>Alpinia oxyphylla</i> , which can induce apoptosis and has anticancer and anti-inflammatory activities ^[1] .
In Vitro	Yakuchinone A acts on A375P, B16F1, B16F10, A549, MCF-7 and HT-29 cell lines with the IC ₅₀ values of 14.75, 31.73, 21.71, 26.07, 11.50 and 11.96 μM, respectively ^[1] . Yakuchinone A (0-64 μM, 16 h) can reduce IL-17 production in a dose-dependent manner and the IC ₅₀ value is 11.5 μM in EL4 (a mouse lymphoma cell line) cells ^[2] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.

In Vivo

Yakuchinone A (50 mg/kg, i.p., daily, 14 days) can reduce the symptoms of EAE in mice in autoimmune encephalomyelitis (EAE) mouse model^[1].

Animal Model:	Female C57BL/6 mice ^[1]
Dosage:	50 mg/kg
Administration:	i.p., daily, 14 days
Result:	Showed a significant EAE score reduction from Day 9 to Day 15 after EAE onset.
