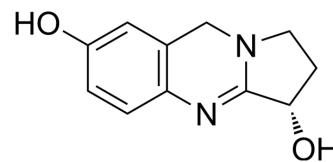

BIOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Description

Vasicinol is a reversible inhibitor of sucrase (IC₅₀: 250 μM). Vasicinol is a HbF inducer. Vasicinol also inhibits Angiotensin-converting Enzyme (ACE). Vasicinol is a pyroquinazoline alkaloid that can be isolated from *Adhatoda vasica*^{[1][2]}.
